NIDEC COPAL ELECTRONICS CORP. was established in April, 1967 as a specialty manufacturer of electronics components. The Company's corporate policy is to supply high-quality products at low prices. COPAL ELECTRONICS began by developing a wirewound trimmer. This product was enthusiastically received by many sectors in industry. This initial success laid the groundwork for future development at the start of the electronics revolution.

Later, robust sales of cermet trimmers led to the Company's remarkable expansion. Further development efforts led to the release of a succession of new product lines. These included ranges of motors, encoders, switches and pressure sensors.
